National ACEC Award Winner!

On December 1, RESPEC and the South Dakota DENR were awarded an American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) National Honor Award for Engineering Excellence for their work on the Big Sioux River Flood Information System (BSRFIS).

The BSRFIS is the first South Dakota Project to be recognized with a National Honor Award, and a top 36 project of the year in the country.

The project was completed in 2018 and won the joint SDES/ACEC project of the year in 2019. The National Honor Award was announced at the 2020 ACEC Engineering Excellence Awards Gala.

Big Sioux River Flood Information System (BSRFIS)

The project created a one-stop web platform to access real-time stream conditions, flood forecasts, visualizations, and inundation maps. The system helps decision-makers, emergency management staff, and the public to confidently plan responses to weather events.

The BSRFIS serves as a hub of flood information for the 321,000 residents of the Big Sioux River Basin. The BSRFIS covers 8,430 sq. miles and is calibrated to the last 30 years of observed watershed conditions. Photos provided by RESPEC
