SDES 59th ANNUAL CONFERENCE

OUTSTANDING ENGINEERING ACHIEVEMENT AWARD: Big Sioux River Flood Information System

"In 2016, the State of South Dakota commissioned the development of the Big Sioux River Flood Information System. The Flood Information System is a two-part web platform including access for the public and flood-response teams. The first part is a public site <u>Big Sioux</u> with access to stream conditions at over 50 locations throughout the Big Sioux River Basin and a library of over 8,000 inundation maps, representing flood scenarios for five different communities. The second part is a site reserved for state and community officials and includes access to real-time flood inundation forecasts. When flood events are predicted, the hydro-logic output is run through models and predicted inundation maps are loaded to the web platform." – Wes Philips, Eastern Chapter
